

ENCINO PARK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION SWIMMING POOL RULES

LIFEGUARDS: The Pool Manager and the lifeguards are responsible for pool operations and for the enforcement of all pool rules. On duty lifeguards may answer questions, but must not be engaged in continuous conversation. The Association Manager, Pool Manager and Lifeguards have the authority to remove any person from the pool for violation of rules or conduct contrary to good order and discipline, or *detrimental to the health and safety of others*. *Pool games permitted* at the discretion of the lifeguards.

Horseplay and running are forbidden at all times.

Children will be admitted to the pool without any accompanying responsible individual only if they can swim two widths of the shallow segment of the pool, without touching the bottom or resting on the walls. Lifeguards are authorized to administer this swimming test to any person fifteen years of age or younger. *A resident adult must accompany guests that are under 11 years of age and are responsible for the conduct of their guests. Siblings or babysitters accompanying children under 11 years of age must be at least 16 years old.*

The pool is not a babysitting or day care center.

2. **INJURIES:** ALL INJURIES MUST BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED TO THE LIFEGUARD FOR RECORDING IN THE ACCIDENT LOG.

3. **MISCELLANEOUS:** Persons with known contagious skin disorders or other contagious illnesses will not be allowed to enter the pool.

Persons with open wounds will not be allowed in the pool. No bandages allowed in the water except specially designed bandages that are designed to be in the water (and do not fall off).

Persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed within the pool enclosure.

Chewing gum and chewing tobacco products are not permitted in the pool area. Smoking will be permitted on the grassy areas.

NO GLASS CONTAINERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE FENCED AREA OF THE POOL.

Flotation devices attached to a swimmer for safety reasons are allowed only in the shallow end of the pool, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian in the water. Lifeguards may ban flotation devices when they are creating a safety hazard or a nuisance for other swimmers. Children wearing flotation devices must be accompanied by a parent and the parent must stay within arm's reach of the child unless the child is wearing a U.S. Coast Guard approved life jacket.

The use of skates, skateboards, bicycles and similar devices are prohibited within the pool enclosure.

Children in diapers are permitted in the pool if rubber pants or "Little Swimmers", specially designed diapers, are worn.

CHILDREN IN THE WADING POOL ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN, NOT THE LIFEGUARDS.

4. **ADULT SWIM:** Adult swim will be 15 minutes before the hour. Swimmers must be 16 years of age or older. All other persons must be completely out of the pool. Parents may practice swimming skills with children three years and under.

5. **WADING POOL:** Children four years of age and younger are permitted in the wading pool.

6. **PRIVATE PARTIES:** All private pool usage will terminate at 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday and at 10:00 p.m. all other days.

7. **REGISTRATION:** Prior to using pool facility, a resident will be required to register by completing a registration form that lists household members, and be in good standing with the Association.

8. THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY POOL PERSONNEL:

Rules to be enforced everyday!!!

- No running.
- No diving in the shallow end.
- Must jump or dive off the side of pool front first without flips.
- Swimmers in the shallow end must jump away from the edge straight.
- Make sure no one jumps in too close to another person already in the water.
- No jumping off the side of the pool onto a raft or flotation device.
- No jumping off the side over the stairs.
- No standing on rafts.
- No standing or sitting on shoulders.
- If a swimmer in the deep end cannot stand on the bottom with his head above water and cannot swim well, he will be required to go to the shallow end.
- Swimmers are not allowed to go off diving boards with flotation devices, goggles, face masks, or flippers.
- NO RUNNING ON THE DIVING BOARDS.
- Parents *will be* permitted under the diving boards for the purpose of assisting child *with the permission of the Lifeguard.*
- Anyone going off diving board must go off the front edge of the board straight ahead and then be able to swim to the closest ladder to the diving board.
- One person may be on the diving board at a time. Each diver must wait until the diver ahead of him swims to the ladder *and must wait for the diver from the other diving board to also reach the ladder.*
- Only one bounce is permitted when going off the diving board.
- Ball playing will be allowed only at the discretion of the guards. Balls must be soft and are not allowed when the pool is crowded.
- No seat drops off the diving board.
- No swimming between the diving boards and the deep end ladders.

9. POOL GUEST FEE POLICY

DAILY RATE

All non-resident guests will be charged a \$2.00 admission fee. This applies to out-of-town house guests as well as in-town guests. All guests will be charged, both swimmers and non-swimmers. Up to ten guests are allowed when accompanied by the resident.

All guests must register when they enter the pool area. All non-resident guests must be accompanied by an EPHOA resident.
