## Message from the Board

Greetings,

For 40 years, Encino Park has been a top tier community in San Antonio. We have the best neighbors, the prettiest houses (did you know we are made up of over 14 different builders?), a beautiful park to play in with tennis courts, a basketball court and, of course, our stunning pool. As you know, our pool is the staple of summertime. We celebrate big events, have diving board competitions and build great memories at our pool.

With that being said, our pool is 40 years old. We have undergone multiple repairs, resurfacing, and even rebuilt the pool house this past year. In May of this year, our long-time pool company noticed that we were losing at least two inches of water a day. After researching the water loss, they recommended that we have the pool checked for a leak – of which was confirmed. We have literally filled our pool two times a week and are paying double in chemicals to keep the pool maintained and up to par for our community. In early June, a crack in the foundation of the pool developed and is slowly deteriorating the surface of the pool, showing that the leak is definitely present.

To repair the leak, the pool would need to be closed for two weeks, as long as the repair company does not find any other problems. Sadly, with a 40 year pool, and a leak that has already started to show on the surface, the chances are high that the pool would have an extended closure.

After several long discussions, we on the Board have voted that the pool will remain open through Labor Day Monday. During normal seasons, the pool would remain open until September 30, but this year the pool will close on Tuesday, September 5. Please understand this was a very hard decision. We know the importance of the pool and the summer enjoyment. But we also know the crucial need to repair whatever is happening underneath the pool and the surrounding foundation so we can continue year after year of our beautiful amenity.

#### **Market Days and General Information**

- 1. There are two inside areas: The Bay Area (9'x9' booth space) and the Banquet Area (4'x6' booth space with 6' table & 1 chair provided).
- 2. Outside booth spaces are approximately 10'x10' and are located either on concrete or grass. Vendors must provide their own protection from the elements. A canopy is recommended.
- Display backdrop (provided by exhibitor) not to exceed
  6' in height. No display backdrops may be used at indoor table spaces.
- 4. One vendor per booth only, with **no subletting, sharing or re-leasing** of the booth space.
- 5. All vendors are expected to **operate for the full duration of the Market Days event.**
- 6. The staff will assign vendor locations. Returning vendors may request specific locations, and every effort will be made to honor requests, but cannot be guaranteed.
- 7. Pictures of crafts or items to be sold must be provided with the application form. EPWC reserves the right to make the final decision regarding acceptance. We ask that all art/ merchandise be in good taste and that you DO NOT display nudes, profanity, obscenity or objectionable materials. The EPWC reserves the right to ask any vendor to remove a specific item or entire booth for failure to comply with these guidelines and no refunds will be given.
- 8. For Vendors who are interested in selling home-made food items, this website should answer all your questions: <u>http://www.texascottagefoodlaw.com</u>. Be advised that we are not responsible, nor do we have any knowledge about the lawful manner to do this. We simply provide you with a rental space for the weekend.
- 9. Your reservation is not final until payment has been received. **There is a \$25 returned check fee that must be paid before the event** if your check is returned by your bank to us.
- 10. In September, you will receive a confirmation email which will include your booth location, additional event information and flyers. Please help us help you by copying/ emailing the flyers and passing them out and/or displaying them at other shows.
- 11. Market Days @ Encino Park is advertised in many ways: ad in the SA Express News, banners on highly trafficked streets, neighborhood newsletters, flyers, Facebook, many craft fair websites and on our HOA web page.
- 12. Set up for inside vendors will begin Friday night from 6-8pm. Doors will close promptly at 8pm and re-open on Saturday morning at 7:00am. NO EPWC ORGANIZ-ERS WILL BE ON THE PREMISES UNTIL 6PM FRIDAY. It is imperative that once you have unloaded, you move your vehicle so that other vendors can unload.
- 13. There is no security provided on Friday night. Any vendor setting up on Friday does so at their own risk.
- 14. DO NOT PARK YOUR VEHICLE AROUND THE PARK / COMMUNITY CENTER DURING SHOW HOURS. Encino Rio Street Parking should be available for your customers! Vendor parking is at the pool parking lot or side streets (Creek Country or Creek Hill).

- 15. All vendors participating in our show MUST upon checking in donate an item from your product line for our EPWC Holiday Silent Auction. All monies raised are donated to a local charity.
- 16. Each vendor is responsible for removing from their booth and any trash/garbage.
- 17. Alcoholic beverages of any kind are not allowed. Food and drinks will be sold. A vendor may bring in food/drink for personal consumption. Smoking is not permitted.
- 18. Add \$25.00 for any applications postmarked after September 6th.All payments made after September 6th must be in guaranteed funds (cashier's check or money order). Entry fee will not be refunded after September 6, 2023.
- 19. Should COVID-19 Guidelines prevent gatherings of large groups or have restrictions that impact Market Days full refunds will be given.



## Protect Your Plants While On Vacation

The kids have been out of school awhile and you're planning that much needed summer vacation — maybe for a week or longer. But what will you do about your plants and lawn while you're away?

Just like you would for your pets, it's important to plan ahead to help your plants survive the separation.

Here are a few tips to get you started:

- 1. If it hasn't rained in the past 10-14 days, water your lawn deeply before you leave.
- 2. Vegetable gardens and container plants will need watering every third day or so enlist the help of a friendly neighbor.
- 3. Mow the lawn one day before you leave, but don't lower the mower blades as it will stress the lawn.
- 4. "Deadhead" spent perennials and annual flowers.
- 5. Add mulch to areas where there is none to help plants retain water and reduce soil temperature.
- 6. Harvest all ripe or nearly ripe vegetables (Give some to the kind neighbor tending to your garden!). It will soon be time to start the fall vegetables in mid-August.
- 7. Soak houseplants thoroughly and store them in a bathtub or large cattle trough with a few inches of water; the plants will absorb it as needed through the container drain hole.

Now that you've prepared your plants, rest easy knowing they'll be alive and well when you return. Enjoy that vacation!





## Cheesecake Stuffed Strawberries

Try these easy red, white, and blue Cheesecake Stuffed Strawberries for a healthier patriotic dessert! A super easy to make, no-bake dessert that is light, fruity and delicious. Low carb and keto friendly.



#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 24 + large fresh strawberries (1 ½ to 2 lbs, depends on how much you fill them)
- 1 (8oz) package cream cheese, room temperature or softened slightly
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup fresh blueberries

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut the stems from the strawberries, so the strawberries can sit cut-side down.
- 2. Cut a deep "X" from the tip down, being careful not to cut all the way through.
- 3. Beat the cream cheese, powdered sugar, and vanilla in a bowl with a hand mixer until nice and fluffy.
- 4. Gently open up each strawberry and pipe the filling inside using a pastry bag or zip-top bag with a star piping tip. Don't have a pastry bag or piping tip? Just cut off the corner of a zip-top bag and squeeze the cheesecake filling inside the strawberries that way.
- 5. Top each filled strawberry with a blueberry. These are best served after the strawberries have been chilled for at least an hour. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator up to 3 days depending on how firm/soft the strawberries are.

## ARE YOU PREPARED FOR HURRICANE SEASON?



The recent winter storm in Texas made it essential for us to be prepared for the next weather emergency. We discovered our critical needs were water and electricity, which is typically the case in extreme weather disasters.

The most notable weather emergencies in our part of the state and surrounding areas are hurricanes, tornados, rain/hailstorms, and flooding. Severe weather emergencies sometimes happen when we least expect: Be prepared and avoid personal injury and property damage by doing some preliminary planning.

Our Gulf Coast hurricane season runs from June 1 to November 30 and can cause winds as high as 100 mph and severe thunderstorms capable of producing large hail and wind gusts over 58 mph. We have no control when, where, or how disasters strike, but we can do some planning to prepare to deal with a disaster.

In case of evacuation, a bag/kit packed with emergency/disaster supplies. Sometimes called a Get Home Bag (GHB) or Bug-out Bag (BOB), you should include:

- Fresh water
- Flashlights and batteries
- Non-perishable foods and snacks (simple, easy to prepare)
- Extra clothing
- Blanket/sleeping bag
- Medications/prescription information

- List of emergency contact numbers
- Important documents to include car, medical, and homeowner's insurance.
- First aid kit including hygiene products/toiletries
- Communication devices with chargers
- · Battery-operated or hand-cranked radio

Your GHB should only contain very basic necessities. Your bag is only meant to protect you when you must shelterin-place or leave your home for a short period of time during a natural disaster.

We should always be alert and monitor our local weather updates and emergency instructions, especially during hurricane season. Keep an emergency bag packed and your vehicle fueled in case you must evacuate your home. Stay prepared. Keep your emergency bag packed and be aware and understand the type of hazardous weather that can affect you and your family where you live.
